Sir,

Legal Education Committee at its meeting held on 28th July, 2013 considered the inspection report of the above mentioned college. After consideration, Committee made the following recommendations:-

The Legal Education Committee considered the recommendations of Standing Committee. After consideration, the Committee is of the view that Monad University, Hapur be recognized under Section 7 (1) (i) of the Advocates Act, 1961 for the purpose of conferring the degrees in law for imparting three year LLB, five year BA. LLB (Hons.) and five year BBA. LL.B (Hons.) courses and also Monad School of Law, Monad University, Hapur be granted temporary approval of affiliation for running three year LL.B, five year BA.LL.B (Hons.) and five year BBA.LL.B (Hons.) courses for a period of two years i.e. for the academic years 2013-2014 and 2014-2015 with an intake of two sections of 60 students in each section in each course.
